

INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) LOCAL SMALL, MEDIUM & MICRO ENTERPRISES (SMMES) OF CONSTRUCTION SUB-CONTRACTORS: MOUTSE DROUGHT INTERVENTION PROJECT ISSUE DATE: 21 APRIL 2020

BACKGROUND

Lepelle Northern Water (LNW) was appointed by the Department of Water & Sanitation as the Implementing Agent for the Moutse Drought Relief Intervention Project.

One of the project packages for the Emergency Intervention Project is the Construction of Brick Tank Stands for the installation of 5000L Polyethylene Tanks to be utilised as a temporary water supply solution.

The work will include site clearance, earthworks (foundation excavations & compactions), the building work and plumbing connections.

COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT

LNW is required to align with the National Development Plan 2030 principles of ensuring that government infrastructure development projects create jobs for local communities. In alignment to this, LNW is calling for interested SMMES/sub-contractors who would like to be considered potential sub-contracting opportunities to express their interest by being screened for possible work in the construction of tank stands.

MANDATORY AND ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

1. Company must be registered on the Government's Central Suppliers Database proof must be attached. (Compulsory)
2. Company must be registered by the Construction Industry Development Board with a CIDB Grading of 1GB / 1CE proof must be attached. (Preferably)
3. Companies must be based / residing in the Wards under the Moutse Area ONLY in the Elias Motsoaledi and Ephraim Mogale Local Municipalities will be CONSIDERED therefore it is mandatory for interested companies to include a valid municipal account or tribal authority confirmation or proof of residence for this specific area. (Compulsory)
4. Companies must clearly state the Local Municipality, Ward Number and Village Name from where they are based / are residing. (Compulsory)
5. Certified ID copies of all directors of the company (Compulsory)

Brickwork	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At least 1 qualified and experienced bricklayer per team. Number of labourers to be determined by subcontractor, but at least 3 per team is recommended. The bricklayer must have an NQF recognised building qualification. 2. List of all Hand tools to be supplied / provided by subcontractor for use by his teams. 3. Full time quality on site supervision. Supervisor must have good experience in brickwork projects. 4. Bricklayer must be able to lay at least 750 stock - bricks per day. 5. Nothing less than superior quality will be accepted All walls to be clean, level and plumb. 6. Every tank stand must be completed within the time - frame of the set project programme. 7. Interpretation of drawings essential
Tank Installation & Plumbing Works	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Experience in plumbing work - Needs to be able to successfully install every component needed to plumb the tank stands with no leaks and good quality workmanship. 2. Management or Onsite Supervision ability must be on such a level as to not incur additional administrative, logistical and managerial responsibilities on the Main Contractor.
