Tenderers who have disputed municipal rates and taxes and/or services towards the Municipality or other services suppliers in respect of which payments are overdue for more than 30 days will automatically be disqualified. Municipal account submitted may be verified with the relevant municipality. Only municipal accounts less than 3 months will be accepted. Should the tenderer be renting in a leased property, both lessor and lessee's agreement must be furnished together with the landlord's municipal account or statement. Municipal accounts for the last three months must be submitted together with the tender documents (failure to comply with the above requirement will lead to disqualification).

NOMINATIONS TO THE COMMISSION FOR THE PROMOTION AND PROTECTION OF THE RIGHTS OF CULTURAL, RELIGIOUS AND LINGUISTIC COMMUNITIES

1. The Minister for Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs hereby, in terms of Section 11(1) of the 2002 Act 19 of 2002, invites organisations and individuals within cultural, religious and linguistic communities of South Africa to nominate persons for appointment to the Commission for the Promotion and Protection of the Rights of Cultural, Religious and Linguistic Communities.

2. A nominee must:
a. Be a South African citizen;
b. Be a fit and proper person to hold office as a member of the Commission;
c. Subscribe to the objects of the commission, namely:
i. To promote respect for and further the protection of the rights of cultural, religious and linguistic communities;
ii. To promote and develop peace, friendship, humanity, tolerance and national unity among and within cultural, religious and linguistic communities;
iii. To foster mutual respect among cultural, religious and linguistic communities;
iv. To promote the right of communities to develop their historically diminished heritage; and
v. Reconfirm the establishment or recognition of community councils.

3. A nominee must be a person who is not disqualified to be a member of the Commission in terms of Sections 10(2) of the Act.

4. Nominations must meet the requirements of Section 9 of the Act to ensure that the Commission is composed in such a way that:
a. Is at least broadly representative of the main cultural, religious and linguistic communities in South Africa;
b. Broadly reflects the gender composition of South Africa.
