What's in it for Partners

Partner Portal

A portal where partners can aggregate and make opportunities available for young people and have full view of youth in their own networks:

Portal will enable CBOs to:

- Upload lists of youth in their network (youth still need to join, but this enables partners to track those who are in the network and their EJ)
- Partners will be able to get reports of their network and understand their network engagement and their work status
- Partners will be able to upload opportunities so that young people in the network can access them
